Minutes

- 1. Apologies for absence.** All were present
- 2. Minutes of the least meeting.** Had been sent to all committee members and were on the website
- 3. Matters arising from the minutes.** There were no matters arising.
- 4. a) Chairman's report.** We had had a good year with all planned events taking place including two stays away at Portland and the Wye Valley. No OHJAC groups had taken part in any charity walks.

b) Secretary's report. Any relevant emails had been forwarded to members while those to do with climbing were ignored. Relevant post was circulated at the meeting for possible inclusion on the website. These were from the YMCA National Centre, Lakeside promoting accommodation at Bell Cottage, Glenridding available to groups of up to 16 people and Collette's <http://www.colletts.co.uk/> with their Europe brochure and details of their Yorkshire Dales walking lodge and B&B in Wensleydale which has special offers from time to time <http://www.eastfieldlodge.co.uk> Renewal details from the BMC were being sent out on 1st December, the group membership fee will stay as £250 for the first 20 members. Member's details are required by the BMC by about 22nd February with our renewal cheque due 1st March. We discussed the merits of staying with the BMC and agreed we should stay with them for insurance cover.

c) Treasurer's report. We have £137.55 in our account at present, £30 more than last year due to 2 new members. Our only outgoings are the annual membership fees to the BMC of £250 and the YHA £25.50 so if we kept the membership fee at £20 we would maintain a healthy balance. This was agreed by the rest of the committee.

d) Event secretary's report. Only one walk, the Mince Pie walk was on the website at present but had a number of suggestions for the year ahead. Chris Fitzroy has suggested 3 linear walks following sections of the 2 Moors Way which cross the National Park, we would need to use cars and buses Salcombe Down Domino Walk still there for people to do and may plan a new version on Woodbury Common. Pete would like any photos of previous OHJAC events which have no pictures on the website. These could be either digital or hard-copy. It is the 25th anniversary of the first Adult Walks in October 2012.
